Clinton Community College COVID-19 plan for Spring 2022

Clinton Community College would like to welcome faculty, staff and students to the beginning of the Spring 2022 semester! While Covid-19 continues to be a part of our planning for this semester, we are excited to continue offering in-person classes and student activities this spring.

SUNY has adopted a policy which requires mandatory vaccination of students returning to in-person instruction. Students can personally input their vaccination status at <https://suny.edu/StudentVaccinationPass/> for convenience (the instructions to input vaccine information will be sent to all students on December 10, 2021).

Clinton Community College Covid-19 protocol:

- All members of the College community are required to continue to wear a mask in all indoor public facilities and classrooms of the college (effective August 23, 2021).
- Please practice social distancing and sanitize your hands frequently.
- Please remain home if you are not feeling well, have a fever over 100 or believe you have been exposed to the Covid-19 virus.
- The Clinton County Health Department is an excellent resource for questions regarding Covid, vaccine and booster availability and protocol if you have been exposed to the virus.
- All faculty and staff are required to provide documentation of their Covid vaccine to the Human Resource Office.
- All students attending any on campus classes are required to provide documentation of their Covid vaccine to the College Nurse, Ms. Sandra Marland, sandra.marland@clinton.edu, by Monday, January 3, 2022. All students are mandated by SUNY to have the vaccine series before classes begin on January 24, 2022.
- Currently unvaccinated faculty and staff as well as students who have been granted a vaccination exemption will be required to participate in the campus "Pool Testing" program each week on Thursday. Testing will begin on January 6, 2022, in Stafford Atrium from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm for faculty and staff.
- All college members who are fully vaccinated will be required to participate in the "Pool Testing" program, once a month. The first tests will be scheduled on Wednesday, January 26 from 1:00 to 3:00 PM and Thursday, January 27, 2022, from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm in Stafford Building Atrium.
- Directions for pool testing and registering for the test will be available on the college web site.
- Please be advised the Covid protocols/guidelines may be updated accordingly by the College Administration in complying with the NYS Department of Health, CDC, or SUNY directives.
