SUNY Plattsburgh General Education Program (GE5)

A. THE SKILLS REQUIREMENTS: 6 - 12 (plus 0 - 7 credits to meet prerequisites)

1. Written Expression: 3-4 credits (plus 0-4 credits of ENG 100 to meet prerequisite

2. Oral Expression: 0-3 credits

3. Mathematics: 3-4 credits (plus 0-3 of MAT 101 credits to meet prerequisite)

4. Information and Technology Literacy: 0-1 credits

B. THE KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING REQUIREMENTS: 12 – 16 (plus 0 – 3 credits in prerequisites)

4. Either World Systems **OR** Foreign Language: 0-3 credits (plus 0-3 credits of first semester foreign language to meet prerequisite)

C. ADDITIONAL SUNY GENERAL EDUCATION COURSES: 2 - 12 credits

Additional SUNY-approved courses from categories A and/or B to bring total general education course credits for sections A, B, and C to a minimum of 30. Credits received in the Information and Technology Literacy category do not count toward the minimum 30 credits of SUNY-approved general education courses.

D. THE INTEGRATION REQUIREMENTS: 3 - 4 credits

Global Issues: 3-4 credits

TOTAL CREDITS: 33 – 34 (plus 0 – 10 credits in prerequisites)

NOTES:

- 1. According to SUNY policy, transfer students who have satisfied the SUNY General Education Requirements at the sending institution will be considered to have completed all SUNY Plattsburgh General Education Requirements except for the Integration Requirement (Global Issues 5 GLO).
- 2. First-level Foreign Language courses (CHI101, FRE101, and SPA101) may be used in Category C of GE5 (*Additional SUNY General Education Courses*), although by themselves they do not satisfy the requirement of a second-level Foreign Language course if the Foreign Language category is chosen in Category B.
- 3. SUNY Plattsburgh awards general education credit to many CCC courses that are not designated as general education courses on our campus. This occurs when the course equivalencies at SUNY Plattsburgh are approved general education courses. Upon accepting transfer credits for those courses, SUNY Plattsburgh grants the appropriate general education credits.
