Head Coach, Bowling

RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the general supervision of the Athletic Director, the individual in this position creates and manages teams to provide students a chance to participate in inter-varsity bowling competitions at the collegiate level. Additional responsibilities include but not limited to: Recruiting, game/practice planning, player development, program expansion and supporting the academic success of student athletes. The Coach is expected to be present and available at all scheduled meets and practices, to recruit student athletes and provide support for students in the bowling program.

Primary Duties

- Ensure that the Clinton Community College bowling program conforms with standards and requirements of the college, Mountain Valley League and the National Junior College Athletic Association.
- Recruits student athletes for the team in coordination with the Athletic Director.
- Provides encouragement and support for student academic growth, supports college and NJCAA standards for academic performance.
- Manages and directs players during games according to collegiate standards for sportsmanship and the rules of the college athletic associations.
- Responsible for motivation of student athletes whereby players find success in working hard to accomplish goals, and in an objective manner respects each athlete's individual ability.
- Schedules, coordinates, mentors and coaches team members during practice sessions.
- Will serve to chauffeur team (college vehicles) in traveling to out-of-town competitions in accordance with college policy; have a valid NYS or Vermont driver's license.
- Assist the Athletic Director in providing a supportive environment for the student athletes to succeed academically and in their sport.
- As a member of the Clinton Community College coaching staff, maintains professionalism at all times.

QUALIFICATIONS

An Associate's or Bachelor's degree preferred. Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of the bowling sport. Ability to appropriately and effectively direct, encourage, and guide team members with a diversity of backgrounds, personalities, and abilities. Ability to work in an educational setting.

Must have a valid New York or Vermont driver's license. The offer will be contingent on passing a criminal background check. Compensation for this position will be up to \$3,500 for the season, depending on experience.
